

City of St. Clair 175th Anniversary Parade Official Entry Form

Entry Fee can be paid by Check, Cash, or over phone with credit or debit card. Date: Saturday, May 19th, 2018 Time: 10:00 AM Line Up - Parade Starts at 11:00 AM

1. Early Entry fee: **\$10.00 By May 5th** Late Entry Fee: **\$20.00 after May 5th**

2. Only entries received by May 5th, 2018 will be judged.

3. ALL entries must be self-propelled, motor pulled or horse drawn.

4. Units should be constructed and decorated so that viewing from either side is equally appealing.

5. All entries must have an easily accessible fire extinguisher on the float or towing vehicle, and a kit for repairing minor repairs is recommended!

6. Generators, converters, and batteries may be used to power floats. The energy source must be large enough to safely provide adequate power to meet the needs of your float.

7. Floats using gas powered generators must be sure exhaust fumes are safely ventilated to prevent any danger to the float riders.

8. No one will be allowed to get on or off the floats once the parade starts down the parade route!

9. In the interest of safety, throwing candy from the floats is discouraged. We would like each unit to provide walkers to hand out candy etc.

10. Disposal of float, and vehicle materials is the responsibility of the sponsoring organization and/or individuals.

11. ALL floats or vehicles must be in position by 10:45 AM on May 19th, 2018 (line up at the St. Clair High School parking lot; parade will dismiss at Evergreen Park.)

12. Parade numbers will be used to identify entries and must be displayed on both sides of the float or vehicles so that judges can easily see them. Parade numbers will be issued May 5th, 2018 so that you can place your own number on float or we will provide them at the line-up the day of parade.

13. ALL float sponsors are responsible for providing all riders and walkers with transportation to their vehicles at the end of the parade route.

We hope you will be interested in the 2018 City of St. Clair Anniversary Celebration Parade which will be held on Saturday, May 19th. The Anniversary Celebration will immediately follow the parade with a picnic in the park (bring those blankets, baskets, & drinks), where we will provide a free cupcake, entertainment, & a community balloon launch to commemorate unity & our heritage.

The parade will line up at the St. Clair High School (1015 High School Dr.); we ask that you check in at 10:00 AM. Please enter the line up from Highway 30 as the Bardot Street entrance will be blocked. The parade will begin at 11:00 AM and will travel onto Bardot Street (crossing Highway 30), make a right onto E. Springfield Road, then a left onto Main Street, and a right onto Park Avenue where it will end at the Anniversary Celebration at Evergreen Park.

Following the parade, there will be an awards ceremony at the Anniversary Celebration being held at Evergreen Park. Trophies will be given to the winner in each of the below listed categories:
