FALL CLEAN-UP

Thursday, October 31 – Saturday, November 2, 2019 (7:30am-3:30pm)

For many years, the City of St. Clair has held both spring and fall clean-ups designed to help residents and property owners in St. Clair clean up and dispose of excess trash and bulk items. The city will have dumpsters available for city residents to dispose of large items.

The following steps will be taken to help curb illegal dumping and misuse of the clean-up:

1. All persons dropping off items at the clean-up **must be a resident or property owner in the city limits of St. Clair.**
2. Upon arrival at the clean-up, each person **must present both a valid ID and a utility bill** as proof of residency or ownership.
3. Staff will be present to verify these documents and verify that what is being dumped is allowed.
4. Cameras are installed to monitor the property – **any illegal dumping will be prosecuted** under the law.
5. Dumping will be allowed until 3:30pm. Ensure you arrive in **time to complete** the dump by 3:30pm.
6. **No one will be allowed to rummage through the dumpsters** to pick items out, nor will they be allowed on the property to do the same.
7. The dumpsters will be at the City Maintenance Shed, located at 530 Park Avenue.
8. As always, tires, batteries, paint, televisions, electronics, and chemicals will not be accepted.

Leaf Pickup Program

November 18th-26th

One leaf pickup is available to all residents within the city limits of St. Clair. To have leaves picked up, residents must call city hall at 636-629-0333 by Friday, November 13th at 4:30pm. Leaves will only be picked up at addresses that have called City Hall to be placed on the leaf pickup list.

Please place your leaf pile within 5 feet of the street but not in the ditch or around drainage inlets. Please also keep an area around the leaf pile clear of all obstacles. Remember that this is for leaves only.

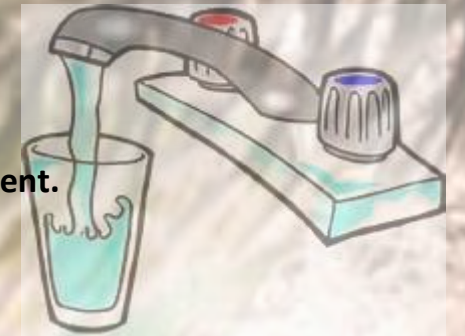

Paying Your Utility Bill Just Got Easier!

The City of St. Clair is excited to launch a handful of new options to pay your utility bill, receive notifications regarding your account and view your address online. That's right—you can now sign up for online viewing, online payments, automatic bank payments, and account notifications on your St. Clair Utility Bill. You also have the option to access your account anytime over the phone.

- Save postage by paying your bill online or by phone.
- Access your updated account instantly.
- Hear & view real-time balances, payments and due dates.
- Secure payments through online payment or phone payment.
- View consumption history and other details online.
- Optimized for mobile devices.
- Convenient ways to pay and view utility bill information
- Sign up to receive account notifications by phone or email.



The online municipal payment site and phone line are now live. Access and view account details for free. Notifications are of no cost, other than standard text message rates. To make a payment online, set up an automatic payment, or make a payment over the phone there is a fee of \$1.25 per transaction. This fee will be charged at the time of payment.
