



**Board of Aldermen Public Hearing Minutes
Monday, August 17, 2020 at 6:50 p.m.**

Mayor Blum called the Public Hearing to order at 6:50 p.m.

Present were Mayor Blum, Administrator Dierker, Alderman Art Viehland, Alderman Cheryl Counts, Alderman Jamie Frossard, Alderman Amanda Sikes and Attorney Voss.

Mayor Blum explained this public hearing is regarding the Property Tax Rate to be set by the City of St. Clair, a political subdivision. Administrator Dierker explained that every year we have to set our property tax rates. He said currently our property tax rate for general municipal purposes is .5497 cents. With the increase of the CPI index and some other minor changes in regards to property tax values and estimations from the county, the proposed increase would go to .5506 cents. He said as far as the park fund goes, it is currently .1716 and the proposed rate would go to .1719 which is a slight increase on each of those by a total of .0012 cents.

Mayor Blum asked if anyone in the public wished to address the board regarding property tax rate for 2021.

Mayor Blum closed this Public Hearing at 6:55 p.m.
