G. Unfinished Business:

1. St. Clair Home Owner Rehabilitation Project – Applications are still being accepted for the local grant project. Eligible applicants have to live within the St. Clair City limits, own their own home, and make less than \$33,950 for a household of two or less; or less than \$39,040 for a household of three or more. To date, **49** applications have been received at City Hall. The City in partnership with Farmers & Merchants Bank and the Federal Home Loan Bank is making 100 grant awards available in 2010.
2. Pseudoephedrine – The Board of Alderman to discuss and consider requiring a prescription for the sale of pseudoephedrine within the city limits of St. Clair.
